



2023 Income Disclosure Statement

Ruby Ribbon Independent Stylists earn between 20 -40% commissions on personal sales and may be eligible for leadership bonuses based on their team's sales. The chart below shows the average percent of Independent Stylists that fall within different annual income ranges, and the average number of months in the business. This data is reflective of Stylist earnings for December 2021 - November 2022, and is updated annually.
